Shalini started her career as a solo artist in 2017 by composing and recording her original music. While Colour Chaos was the first band that she officially played with, she has recorded stripped down acoustic versions of two of her original compositions called 'Mountain Child' about the magic of mountains and 'You're Alive' that talks about the uncomfortable truths of asking if we really alive or just existing when we sacrifice our passion in an effort to fit in with societal expectations.

Unwind Center, with a track record of over twenty years, has been teaching music including Drums, Guitar, Keyboard and Vocals to young aspirants in Chennai and Bangalore. The Centre runs a DJ Academy and aims to inspire musicians by providing them with a platform to perform their work, interact with their peers and to share their compositions with those musically inclined.
